How Does Bryan's House Serve At-Risk Families in Our Community?

From our West Dallas facility on Pipestone Road, Bryan's House delivers the following special needs programs and services to at-risk children ages infant to 5 years old of at-risk, low-income families:

Medically Managed Childcare

To children with special medical needs, we provide professional, high-quality, loving care designed to maximize their potential while managing their medical needs. Whether they are impacted by AIDS/HIV, Down Syndrome, Aicardi Syndrome, Autism or Cerebral Palsy, we keep them safe and help them learn. Our 7am to 7pm hours ensure that parents have the time they need to hold down jobs and care for their other children, too.

Weekend Care and Other Special Programs

For busy parents with weekend obligations, we extend our childcare services on two Saturdays a month. We also offer Summer, Spring and other day camps for families and their children.

♥ Family Support Services (FSS Program)

To ensure our families thrive, not just survive; we provide long-term essential case management for families. We wrap around the child and the family to ensure that basic needs are met, and that the home environment is nurturing, loving and physically equipped to provide the child with essential mobility and comfort. Our professional caseworkers help families find and access needed services such as housing, access to transportation, technology, job readiness training, language classes, further education, and other local referral resources in cases of abuse, sex trafficking, loss of spouse, or something unforeseen like a weather emergency.

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Our Story

At Bryan's House, our vital mission holds steady: Parents of children with special medical needs desperately need quality care for their children. They also require respite care and social services to cope with their associated social needs. Our mission is to meet that trio of need.

Our Founding

We were founded at the peak of the HIV/AIDs crisis to care for children suffering from that dreaded, often fatal infection. Little Bryan Allen, whose mother contracted AIDS from a blood transfusion, was the inspiration for our name. In 1985, at only 8 months old, Bryan became one of the first Dallas area children to die from AIDS. Later, his mother Lydia and older brother Matthew also succumbed to AIDS.



Shifting Need

Over the years, while we served more than 15,000 children, easing their suffering and helping the families lead fulfilling lives, medical



advances and education have shifted the need. Today, happily, few children are born with HIV/AIDs. Treatment for those few is significantly more effective; they can lead good, long lives.

Evolving Model

But HIV/AIDS is still prevalent among adults, and their children are born into unstable, fragile households. These children can thrive within the special medically-managed care model that Bryan's House has perfected. Moreover, that model extends smoothly to other medical needs of children. We have shown that our medically-trained caregivers can meet the needs of children with Cerebral Palsy, Autism, Down Syndrome, and more.

Thanks to Bryan's House, these families can hold down jobs, support one another, receive critical counseling and education, and create safe, fulfilling homes where their children can thrive.
